



With respect to Senate Bill 312 and Assembly Bill 312, the Wisconsin Public Health Association (WPHA) and the Wisconsin Association of Health Departments and Boards (WALHDAB) support the creation of a PFAS grant program to assist municipalities with testing, necessary infrastructure, as well as other related priorities. However, WPHA and WALHDAB have concerns about provisions in both bills that place limitations on state government agency authority and ability to identify and address these environmental hazards.
