11	basis because pursuant to Chapter 59 of the Wisconsin Statutes, a County Administrator or
12	County Executive is required to submit an annual budget to the County Board of Supervisors; and

14 15	WHEREAS, budgeting on an annual basis takes up considerable staff time each year
16	that, should Counties be allowed to budget on a biennial basis, would allow staff time to focus on
17	other areas such as strategic planning, implementing policies, and improving County operations
18	on a day-to-day basis; and

20	WHEREAS, budgeting on a biennial basis would place Counties in a better position to
21	incorporate strategic planning into the budgeting process by focusing on the County's long-term
22	objectives and priorities and the strategies necessary to achieve those objectives; and

24	WHEREAS, budgeting on a biennial basis would permit Counties to focus on providing
25	for long-term fiscal health, a Washington County priority objective for a Well Governed and
26	Administered County rather than simply balancing the budget for the immediate year; and

28	WHEREAS, allowing a County to adopt a biennial budgeting process would allow it the
29	freedom to choose a budgeting process that it deems best suited to address the needs of the public it serves;
